






The world has embraced the digital era. But with all its perks comes risks too.




Phishing attacks

323,972 internet users reportedly fell victim to phishing attacks




Cyberattacks

Ransomware attacks

Cybercrime

Data breaches cost businesses an average of \$4.35 million in 2022



Cyberthreat

The most common cyberthreat facing UK businesses in 2022 was phishing (83% of identified attacks)



Retail fraud

Between March 2020 to March 2022, there was a 57% increase in retail and consumer fraud




E-commerce fraud

Online payment fraud is predicted to cost businesses \$343 billion between 2023-2027




Identity theft
